IF WILDFIRE THREATENS ...

Anytime there is wildland fire in the vicinity there are some prudent actions to be taken even before an evacuation warning is issued:

- Review and update your personal evacuation checklist as required
- Locate the items you would plan to take in an evacuation
- Make sure your escape vehicles have at least a half tank of fuel
- Maintain awareness of conditions and be ready to respond promptly

IF CONDITIONS WORSEN OR AN EVACUATION WARNING IS ISSUED ...

- * Load vehicle(s) with essentials from your evacuation checklist.
- Relocate combustible items away from the house (e.g., firewood, BBQ propane tanks, snowblower fuel, deck furniture, umbrellas, mats, cushions, etc.)
- If you have a ladder, prop it up against the roof edge.
- Attach (leak-free) hoses to outside water faucets and attach nozzle.
- Verify that crawl space and attic vents are properly screened or cover with aluminum foil.
- BE PREPARED TO EVACUATE ON VERY SHORT NOTICE.

If you feel uneasy, go ahead and evacate early, before there is an Order.

IF AN EVACUATION ORDER IS ISSUED ...

ACT PROMPTLY:

- Put garbage cans inside the garage; leave house water ON.
- Verify that all doors and windows are closed to prevent ember intrusions.
- For fire safety, wear non-synthetic long sleeved shirts, pants, socks and enclosed shoes; if you have them, bring goggles, N95 mask, gloves and head covering.
- · Carefully depart the area, following instructions from emergency responders

ONCE YOU ARE SAFELY SETTLED, STAY CONNECTED ...

Monitor the local information resources noted above. And PLEASE, do NOT pass around unfounded rumors or speculation; it just causes needless anxiety.
